

## A Complete Prayer Sample

**ADORATION:** I bless your holy name O God for who you are to me. You are great and mighty are the works of your hand. You do not change and you forever remain the same. I praise your majestic and holy name, even now and forevermore, Amen (you may add some songs of praise).

**SUPPLICATION:** Father I ask you for strength and protection. Deliver me from every plan of the enemy and grant me wisdom to make good decisions today..... You may pray for your loved ones, friends, family, neighbors and even your enemies.

**CONCLUSION:** Thank you Father for granting my request according to your divine will and purpose, in Jesus name, Amen!

## Prayer of Warfare (general)

Heavenly Father, I come by way of the blood of Jesus and the victory of Christ over Satan and all his cohorts. Thank you that I have victory over the devil and his plans against my life. Cover me with your whole armor (*Ephesians 6:12*) now I pray. I stand on the authority I have in Christ and declare victory over every scheme of the enemy against my life (personal, family,school, job, etc). I break every yoke and bond of oppression in my life (personal, family, job school, etc). I thank you that no weapon formed against me shall prosper (*Isaiah 54:17*) in Jesus name, Amen.

## Prayer for Healing

Thank you Jesus for bearing all my infirmities on the cross and by your stripes I am healed (*Isaiah 53:5, 1 Peter 2:24*). I therefore command every infirmity (call the disease by name if there is one) to be broken in my life. I receive my healing in the name of Jesus and declare soundness in every fiber of my being. I hereby bind the power behind all aches, pains, anxiety and depression in the name of Jesus and command all associated symptoms to be gone, Amen.

## The Reality of Your Decision

Your recent commitment to serving the Lord was the greatest decision you will ever make in your life. It is a life of **complete trust and total surrender** to Christ Jesus. You have a relationship with God and He is counting on you to get closer to Him everyday through **prayer** (*1 Thessalonians 5:17, Philippians 4:6*), **bible study** (*1 Peter 2:2, Joshua 1:8*), and **fellowship** (*Acts 2:42, Hebrews 10:24-25*).

The decision you have taken implies Jesus is the Lord of your life (body, soul and, spirit) and you are now a child of God (*John 1:12*). To be called a child of God is a privilege reserved only for those who have made personal commitment to Jesus as the Lord and Savior of their lives (*John 1:12, John 14:6*). You have now moved from the control and domain of the devil, to the domain of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ. The devil will try every means possible to either slow your progress in the Lord or cause you to backslide to the place you once were. You must therefore keep **good and godly company** (*1 Corinthians 15:33*) and ask God to keep guard over the **gateways to sin** in your life by way of your five senses (sight, smell, taste, hearing and touch). Your life is now brand new in Christ and all things have indeed become new (*2 Corinthians 5:17*).

## How To Walk With God

Walking with God is a walk of faith and we walk with **God by prayer** (*1 Thessalonians 5:17*), **studying His Word and walking in** obedience to His Word. He is right now living in your heart by way of His Holy Spirit. Even though you neither see Him with your eyes nor feel Him sometimes (especially in your trying moments), He is still more closer to you than you can imagine. He hears anytime you call and will surely answer when you call upon His name (*Jeremiah 29:12, Romans 10:13*).

## Prayer

Prayer is your secret weapon and the master key that unlocks every door of opportunity and shuts every door of destruction. It grants you an unlimited access to the throne room of grace and brings God's presence down into your situation (*Hebrew 4:16, Psalm 91*). Prayer is not confined to an enclosure; be it a temple or a building, but can be done at anytime, no matter the occasion. Notwithstanding, every child of God must have a time set aside during the day, to seek the face of God and to read His word. This must be a time with less distraction from the phone and people, etc. A good recommendation will be early in the morning before daybreak or a quiet time during the day when you are alone and away from all forms of distraction.

## What is Prayer?

Prayer means communicating with God. The Lord cherishes our relationship with Him more than every need we may have. Prayer is done first and foremost because we have a relationship with God and not because we have a need. How do you feel when you get used and abused; when your friends, families and loved ones show up or call solely because they need something from you? Bad I suppose? One may say "well, God is different from man.....". As much as God is different from man, relationships have always been mutual. Every relationship is a give-and-take affair, and God as our heavenly Father desires to hear from His children and be involved in every decision making in their lives. Secondly, God is a king and every king has a protocol that must be observed. When we come into His presence some necessary procedures must be followed, Amen! The disciples of Jesus watched Jesus pray and wanted to know how to pray, they then asked "Lord, teach us to pray.....?" (*Luke 11:1*)

## How Do We Pray?

Jesus taught His disciples how to pray by giving them the recipe (*Luke 11:2-4; Matthew 6:9-14*). The Lord's Prayer; "Our Father which art in heaven....." is about how we pray and not what we pray. Today people say the Lord's Prayer as their day to day prayer still in a liturgical format, without considering the main themes depicted by Jesus in this prayer. Every recipe of prayer must have the following major ingredients given to the disciples by Christ; adoration (*Luke 11:2*), confession (*1 John 1:9*), thanksgiving (*Philippians 4:6*) and supplication (*Philippians 4:6; Matthew 7:7*).

**ADORATION:** Worshiping God both in words and songs of praise.

**CONFESSION:** Confessing every known and unknown sin in your life and also forgiving those who have offended or sinned against you (*Matthew 18:21-22, 35; Colossians 3:13*).

**SUPPLICATION:** Supplicating entails entreating, pleading or calling upon God concerning your needs and issues. It also includes standing in the gap for others with needs. In supplication we ASK "Ask, Seek and Knock" (*Matthew 7:7*).

**THANKSGIVING:** Thanking God is what we do before we begin and conclude our prayer. It is an expression of faith and gratitude to God for doing what we have requested from Him (*Philippians 4:6*). We must always be thankful to God in spite of our circumstances and situations because He promises deliverance from all afflictions (*Psalms 34:19*).
